

# NOTICE OF RACE/Sailing Instructions FRESH WATER RACE

**Saturday, February 23, 2019**

1. **Rules:** This race is governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing except as modified by the STYC General Sailing Instructions (GSI) and this Notice of Race.
2. **Eligibility and Entry Deadline:** This race is open to STYC members and non-members. Entries must be received at the Sloop Tavern or on the website, no later than 1800, on the Wednesday before the race. Entry forms are available at ([www.styc.org](http://www.styc.org)). **Non-members and Associate Members must submit a \$35 entry fee with the completed entry form.**
3. **Divisions and Starting Times:** Entries not clearly specifying FS or NFS will be assumed to be NFS. Division breaks will be posted on the STYC website ([www.styc.org](http://www.styc.org)) by 1800 the Friday before the race. The 1st Division start time is 1100.
4. **Race Format and Course:** This is a single distance race event. Courses will be run on Lake Washington north of the 520 bridge. Race Course: The course will be indicated by any combination A H J K S W mark letters on the course side of the Race Committee boat. See below for description of the letters
5. **Start/Finish :**Start/Finish line will be off the Kirkland Water front near the Kirkland Public Dock (by the Anthony's Restaurant Building)
6. **Time Limit:** The time limit is 6.0 hours. Refer to the GSI for instructions concerning cancellations, postponements and time extensions.
7. **Skippers' Meeting:** A Skippers' Meeting will be held at the Kirkland Public Dock, at 9:30am before the race. Copies of STYC GSI will be available for non-members.
8. **Awards:** Awards will be presented at 1900 on the day of the race at the Anthony's Bar in Kirkland (pending protest hearings). Due to the perishable nature of the prizes, you must be present to collect. Prizes will not be available for pickup at a later time.
9. **Moorage:** Overnight moorage is available at the Kirkland Public docks located in Moss Bay ([https://www.kirklandwa.gov/depart/parks/Permits\\_and\\_Reservations/Kirkland\\_Marina\\_Dock.htm](https://www.kirklandwa.gov/depart/parks/Permits_and_Reservations/Kirkland_Marina_Dock.htm)) and Carillon Point (<https://www.carillon-point.com/guest-moorage/>)
10. Monitor the STYC website ([styc.org](http://styc.org)) for changes to this Notice of Race.

## COURSE MARK DESCRIPTIONS

- A Arrowhead Point. Located due West from Arrowhead point along the centerline of the Lake (47° 44.292, 122°16.600).
- H Hunts Point. Located 200 yards North of Hunts Point (47° 39.226, 122° 13.800).
- J Juanita Point. located 200 yards South of Juanita Point (47° 41.737, 122°13.800).
- K Kirkland buoy. Located 300 yards due West from the end of the Kirkland public dock (47° 40.377, 122°12.700).
- S Sand Point. located 200 yards East of Sand Point (47°40.945, 122° 14.600).
- W Webster's Point. Located 200 yards East of the Green day marker at Webster's Point (47° 38.849, 122° 16.400).
- 2 or 3 This indicates a multi-lap course. Sail the course as many times as is indicated by the number, crossing the finishing line at the completion of each lap.
