

NOTICE OF RACE/Sailing Instructions
BLAKELY ROCK BENEFIT RACE
in memory of Carol Pearl

Saturday, April 4th, 2020



1. **Rules:** This race is governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing except as modified by this Notice of Race and the STYC General Sailing Instructions (GSI) available on the STYC website (www.styc.org).
2. **Eligibility and Entry Deadline:** This race is open to STYC members and non-members with PHRF or STYC ratings. Entries must be received on the STYC website (www.styc.org), no later than 1800, on the Wednesday before the race. See the GSI for late entry policy. There is an entry fee of \$50.00 for **all** yachts payable when entering.
3. **Divisions and Starting Times:** More than two multihulls will have a separate start. Class breaks will be posted on the STYC website (www.styc.org) by 1800 the Friday before the race. The 1st Class start is 1100.
4. **Race Distance and Course:** The course is 13.518 nautical miles and will be as follows:

North wind (all marks to port):	N M K N
South wind (all marks to starboard):	N K M N

There is no provision for a short course.
5. **Time Limit:** The time limit is 6.0 hours. Refer to the GSI for instructions concerning cancellations, postponements, and time extensions.
6. **Skippers' Meeting:** A Skippers' Meeting will be held at the CYC Clubhouse at 0930 on race day. The General Sailing Instructions will be available at STYC website (www.styc.org).
7. **Awards:** Entrants that are current PHRF members and place 1st in class become eligible to participate in Seattle Yacht Club's Grand Prix Regatta in the fall. The Roland Littlefield Church Performance Trophy (FS & NFS) will be awarded to the boat that won his class by the greatest amount on corrected time.
